CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Ms. Harrell asked if any Board member had any conflict of interest with any item on the meeting's agenda. There being no conflict, the agenda was approved.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The Board approved its minutes of December 14, 2017.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed and approved as presented.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

Rules

There are no rules currently at the Rules Review Commission. The Board reviewed the amendments to Rule .0302, .0401, .0902, .0905 and the adoptions of Rule .0405, .1001, .1002, .1003, .1004, .1005, .1006, .1007, .1008, .1009, .1010, .1011, .1012, .1013, .1014. Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the Board adopted the rules and agreed to send the rules to the Office of Administrative Hearings for publication in the NC Register to begin the rules review process.

Status of Amendments to Practice Act

There are no amendments to the Practice Act.

Disciplinary Hearings

Mr. Wilkins informed the Board of proposed Consent Orders regarding: Anthony Ariano, Freddy Barrios and Drew Selisker for practice massage and bodywork therapy without a current license; Scott Mayo for engaging in inappropriate sexual contact with a client; and Arnetta Sturdivant for aiding and abetting illegal massage and bodywork therapy practice. There are five disciplinary hearings scheduled for today.

Licensee Report

17,045 have been issued 8,711 active licenses

Renewal Report

There are 4,017 licensees scheduled to renew for the 2018-2019 renewal period. 3,358 therapists have renewed. 2,612 therapists renewed online and 746 therapists renewed by mail. An online license renewal reminder was sent on December 19, 2017 notifying licensees that their license will expire December 31, 2017 and an expired notice was sent on January 5, 2018. The routine Continuing Education Audit has started for 200 therapists who renewed online.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Policy Committee

Ms. Layden reported the Committee met February 14, 2018 and discussed the matters set forth in the minutes of the Committee.

Continuing Education

a. Request from IASI regarding CE contract

The Committee discussed the request from IASI to contract with the Board for continuing education. The Committee agreed to present the changes to Section .0700 of the Rules and Regulations of the Board to the representatives of IASI to see if the changes meet their request.

b. Update on CE rules

The Committee was informed by Board staff that the CE Ad/Hoc Committee has met to review Section .0700 of the Rules and Regulations of the Board and the amendments will be presented to the Board for approval.

FSMTB

a. Regulatory Education and Competence Hub (REACH) program

The Committee discussed the REACH program. Ms. Harrell and Ms. Foster were informed that FSMTB is developing a subject matter expert group consisting of representatives from NC Board approved schools and massage and bodywork therapy community college programs to assist in the development of the treatment planning/intake course.

b. HT Task Force report response

The Committee reviewed FSMTB's response to the AMTA and ABMP response to FSMTB's Human Trafficking report.

Discussion on Reflexology

The Committee reviewed the history of the reflexology exemption and agreed to keep this topic on the agenda for future discussion.

Presentation by representatives from Massage Envy regarding stretch services

The Committee met with representatives from Massage Envy to provide a presentation and discussion on their stretch services. The Committee agreed to continue discussion on this topic.

Follow-up on meeting with Dianne regarding Board finances

Ms. Layden informed the Board she met with Board staff to discuss the Board's current and future finances and the impact of licensure for massage and bodywork therapy establishments.

Email from Narcisa Woods regarding HT awareness signs

The Committee discussed an email from Narcisa Woods regarding human trafficking public awareness signs. Mr. Wilkins agreed to provide a response to Ms. Woods regarding her questions.

Email from Deandra Marinova regarding pediatric massage

The Committee discussed an email from Deandra Marinova regarding pediatric massage and agreed it does not need to be provided on the 'List of Modalities requiring Licensure' on the Board's website because it clearly falls within the definition of massage and bodywork therapy.

2018 Strategic Planning Conference

a. Appearance of the LMBT license

The Board discussed the appearance of the LMBT license and agreed to add a large watermark on the license displaying the years the license is current. The Board also discussed the need to provide all LMBTs with an original license and agreed to take off the reprint license button on the Board's website.

b. Discussion on English proficiency

The Board discussed concerns of English proficiency for individuals attending NC Board approved schools and massage and bodywork therapy community college programs and agreed to contact all of the programs to add a statement in their catalog and Student Enrollment Agreement that requires the student be proficient in the English language.

c. Dry Needling

The Board discussed whether or not dry needling is within the scope of practice of massage and bodywork therapy and agreed dry needling is not within the scope of practice of massage and bodywork therapy.
